- 1) Call to order
 - 2) Approval of minutes from August, 2011 meeting – approved:

3) Reports

- A) Financial – Desiree Turner not present, but in good shape financially, insurance paid (10,000 plus), money coming from soccer stop and B & H,
 - a. AR October 3 deadline is still coming in... \$25,887.72 outstanding;
 - b. Concern about paying coaches as money comes in, hassle for managers, but unfair to coaches... But this is not much that can be done. Have to pay CYS in June. No known way to change this situation. Some coaches go unpaid, due to non-collections. But plan works for managers
- B) Director – Shaun Howe
 - a. Coaches Meeting last night, want to develop players that can play multiple positions, love the game;
 - b. Query how to help train coaches do new exercises mid-stream; mirror Academy? Do on a Sunday? Would help sell development philosophy (sell players); good plan.
 - c. Recreation program –

- i. Going well;
- ii. Need to line out refs! Need back up plan;
- iii. Who do the rec. coaches contact?; Can we provide a central number? Same if issues arise.
- iv. How to remedy this? May be impossible?
- v. Hard to find centers... Per Tom L, don't know until Saturday. Sean had to fill in; alternatives, use parents? OR - Find somebody to be in charge of rec refs on Saturdays to deal with this problem.
- vi. Difficulty with reporting scores for refs using system
- vii. Suggestion that culture of club needs reinforcement; take it easy on kids and refs; let them play.
- viii. Henry volunteered to give a spiel re: have fun memo.
- ix. Discussion of field management; field conditions, Long's v. Canyon View, logistics vs. capacity, multi-use problems...

d. Upcoming winter programs:

- i. FUTSAL 4v4 or 5v5 w/goalkeeper– what it will look like (Start Dec. Tues-Weds, 11 games (40 minute games), \$70 per player); will be coached.
Developmental approach; city was contacted; may start in December –March (Tues/Wed).
 - 1. Model after 3v3; make it playful, like pick-up
 - 2. First 20 to sign up.
- ii. Winter training – how this will work (start in December – 11 sessions for \$80 per player.
 - 1. Probably Mondays and Thursdays, complement the Futsal league
- iii. Turkey Shootout – Futsal tournament
 - 1. Worked last year; try it again, player and coach buy in... May be a good fundraiser also, and improve players...
- iv. Outdoor winter options (weekend training for those

going to an event – FREE).

- e. ODP Tryouts October 16
 - i. 96-99 ages
 - ii. Mike Freitag will run it
 - iii. Nick and Shaun will be involved
 - iv. Will push local talent
 - v. Good precedent for our club.
 - vi. Have had some success with other local kids.
 - vii. Try to build on our successes; create opportunity

- f. Vail Cup – 9 teams from GJSC attending
 - i. 10/1 and 10/2

- g. NSCAA Convention (coaching education) – Would like a \$1,500 budget to take coaches to Kansas City for 4 days.
 - i. 4 coaches want to go
 - ii. Hofer, Larry, Shaun, Gumps
 - iii. Biggest convention in the world
 - iv. Top line coaches, sports psychs, etc.
 - v. “Soccer mecca”
 - vi. January 11-15, 2012
 - vii. Need to budget for this somehow; may find some money in other allocation;
 - viii. Henry makes a motion to do this right – plane travel, etc. Suggests use investment funds to fly, hotel, meals, no more than 5 coaches; Christi seconds; after discussion Board approves unanimously to investigate using investment funds pending budgetary concerns and final approval.

- h. TOP Soccer Program – about 30 kids registered.
 - i. Going fine; fun; lots of support from other kids.

- ii. Local support from press, professionals, etc.
 - i. Ramona – college recruiter discussion; discussion about whether to bring her out; bargain prices; very experienced.
 - i. Club would host, January 5; try to crossover with college bound soccer players; regain local interest
 - ii. Will do one on ones with kids at a tbd location; Mesa State office.
- C) Referees – Tom Lillpop
- a. 9 new refs – 27 in class. (Grade 9 clinic)
 - b. New castle will have a clinic soon (Grade 8) and then later in Steamboat
 - c. Game scores reporting is a laborious process
 - d. New refs are largely on a positive plane, etc.
 - e. List of refs for hire is being developed; may have Co. Springs tournament list made available (Kohl's/GMIT).
 - f. Need a mentor for young refs.
 - g. Local ref organization (Curt Gustafson) is working on this;
 - h. May need to raise ref budget for rec refs; rec pays less than competitive... Centers paid 14. Pay regularly.
 - i. Gary Krizman may be interested in heading up this mentor program, former local player, active coach...
 - j. Gary could take over rec for example...

 - b. Jessica and Henry showed up, one volunteer.
 - c. May go to an assigned volunteer via teams.
 - d. But this week is covered; making progress
 - e. Information Table was a good idea
