  1. **Playing Levels – All Levels will play 8v8 (We are still waiting for CYS to confirm)**
  2. **Premier Team-CYS State League (Colorado Youth Soccer)** *half of your games will be played on the Front Range. At the U11 age group, most games are Metro Denver. All teams are age specific.*
  3. **United/Inferno Teams-WSSL League (Western Slope Soccer League)** *Half of your games will be in Western CO. towns such as Glenwood, Montrose, Eagle and as far away as Steamboat Springs. Age Bracket is U12. U11 players will play up into a U12 age group due to a lack of players in smaller mountain towns.*
  4. **In house Recreational League.** *Players will play all games in Grand Junction at Canyon View Park on Saturday Mornings. Teams will play 8v8 and could be placed in the U11-U14 Recreational league.*
- **Expectations:** *Premier and United/Inferno Teams are committed to play for a full year (two seasons) Premier teams will train three times per week. United and Inferno teams will train two times a week but could train an additional day if wanted. United and Inferno players could also train with the Premier Team on their off days as well. Recreational teams commit to play per season and train up to two times per week.*
- **Cost of each program (Registration and Coaching):** *Premier team cost \$860.00 per year. United and Inferno teams cost \$625.00 per year. Recreational Soccer cost \$200.00 per year.*
- **Coaching:** *Shaun Howe*
- **Payment options:** *Half Due at time of registration (by June 30th). Other half due by October 5th.*
- **Practice Gear/ when do practices start?/ Where are practices?:** *Each Premier through Inferno player is required to train in the GJSC FIRE FC T-shirt and or Sweatshirt. The price for two t-shirts and one sweat shirt is \$ 30.00 and will be ordered by your team manager in June. Practices will start around July 11<sup>th</sup> for all competitive teams. Games will start on August 25<sup>th</sup>, 2011. All competitive trainings will be at Canyon View Park. Recreational games will start on September 8<sup>th</sup>.*
- **Uniforms:** *Each Premier through Inferno player is required to purchase the Clubs official playing uniforms. This Adidas package consists of two jerseys, one short and two pairs of socks (home and away uniforms). The cost of this package is \$110.00. You will order these uniforms from your team manager in June. Recreational players will use their recreational uniform from the prior year. These uniforms can be purchased at B&H Sports.*
- **Tournaments:** *Each Premier through Inferno team is asked to participate in the Grand Junction, GMIT Tournament in May of each year. In addition, Premier teams will be asked to participate in additional tournaments around the state or region. We encourage United and Inferno teams to play in State tournaments such as the Durango Shoot Out or Glenwood Invitational.*
- **Player Movement within age group:** *It is important to keep in mind that players could be asked to play on a different team within their age group during the year. This could happen for a multitude of reasons but is always done with the player's development in mind.*
